The Philadelphia Mask Arts Symposium is an 8 day celebration and exploration of the ancient art of masks and their current power. Choose from multiple workshops or sign up for the whole week! This incredible 8 day event will include lectures, demos, and in depth workshops for mask making (*neoprene and papier mache*), mask performance and exploration, and theatre making led by master mask teachers Barbara Gregson of Gregson Theatre, Craig Jacobson of The Maskery, Patricia Dominguez and Alan Bell of ArcheDream for Humankind (ADHK), and Benjamin Bass of Broken Mirror Studios. The Symposium will culminate in a free Open House to the public on Oct 1 and 2 which will include a gallery of masks made by the participants along with performances.
